How to enter

Participants must submit their design by Friday, January 9, 2026. Visit https://www.eriecountycouncilpa.gov/i-voted-sticker-contest to complete the online form and submit your artwork with the release form. Participants under the age of 18 must submit a parental/guardian consent form along with their entry.

Note: Any artwork will become the property of Erie County Government.

- All artwork submitted should be original artwork and may not include copyright images
- Artwork should include the phrase I-Voted
- Artwork should be non-partisan and may not promote any party, candidate, or issue
- Artwork may, but is not required to, portray images associated with Erie County
- Entries may be submitted with the template or using your own materials. Don't forget to include your name. Keep in mind the design will be printed on a 2"x2" round sticker.
- A committee will review entries, then the general public will vote on the top designs. The top votegetters design will be featured on the 2026 I-Voted stickers.

By submitting an entry, you acknowledge the artwork is original and will become the property of Erie County Government to use for sticker artwork for Erie County Elections. No compensation will be provided; the artist will be featured on our website and receive a certificate of appreciation.
